How many guests were there?

### Calculation

$$4 + 12 + 5 + \frac{1}{2}x + 1 + \frac{1}{25}x + 1 = x$$

$$\frac{1}{2}x + \frac{1}{25}x + 23 = x$$

$$25x + 2x + 50 \cdot 23 = 50x$$

$$50 \cdot 23 = (50 - 27)x$$

$$x = (50 \cdot 23) / 23$$

### Solution

There were 50 guests.
